
### Administration

We can always depend on our office staff to keep our school business in complete organization.










# Type A
















### Homecoming

evening.






### Art Club


### Pep Club








#### FFA




### Drama Club







#### FTA






### Medical Careers








## Varsity Club


#### Annual Staff





## Boys Intramurals




### Girls Intramurals






## Sponge Week










# Modern Dance and Gymnastics

This trip was an experience that enabled seniors to see first-hand the state legislative process.




## Prom

### Class Revue


This year, the Class of '75 had a new approach for classnight, called the


## Graduation


## Editor's Notes






they did.
