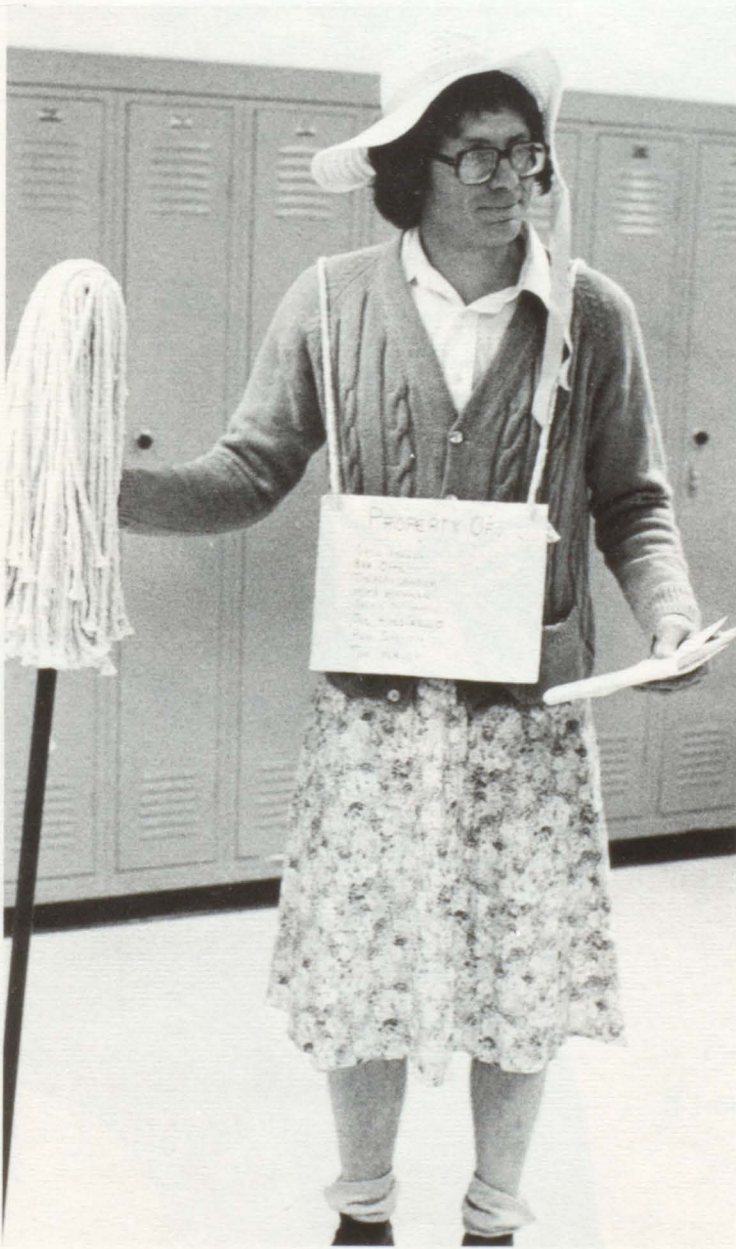
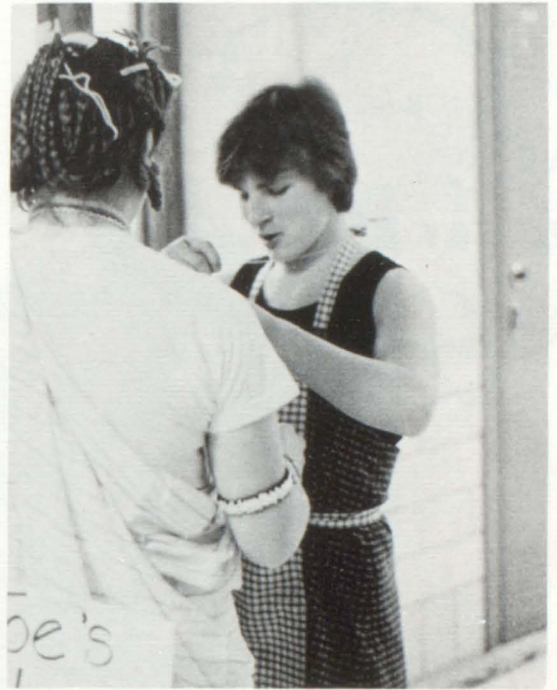
Sponge Week is the only week of the year we have an excuse to be crazy. Anyone visiting the school would think it was a zoo rather than a high school.

Some of the highlights included the Slave Auction with the "three Arabs," seeing the boys actually dress up, and visiting the 1950's and the 1960's.

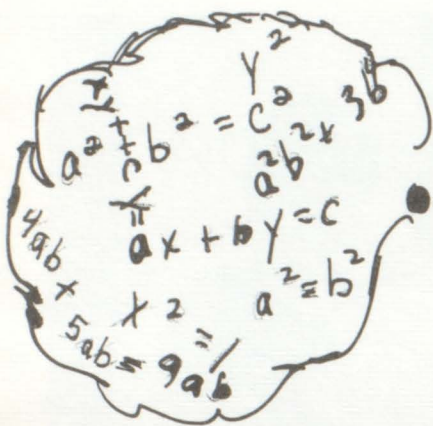

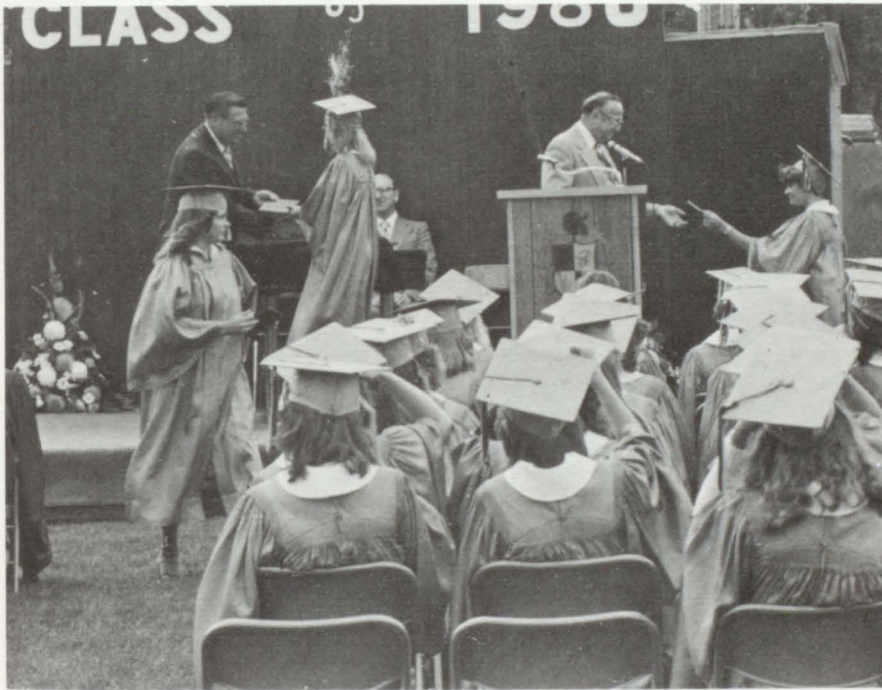
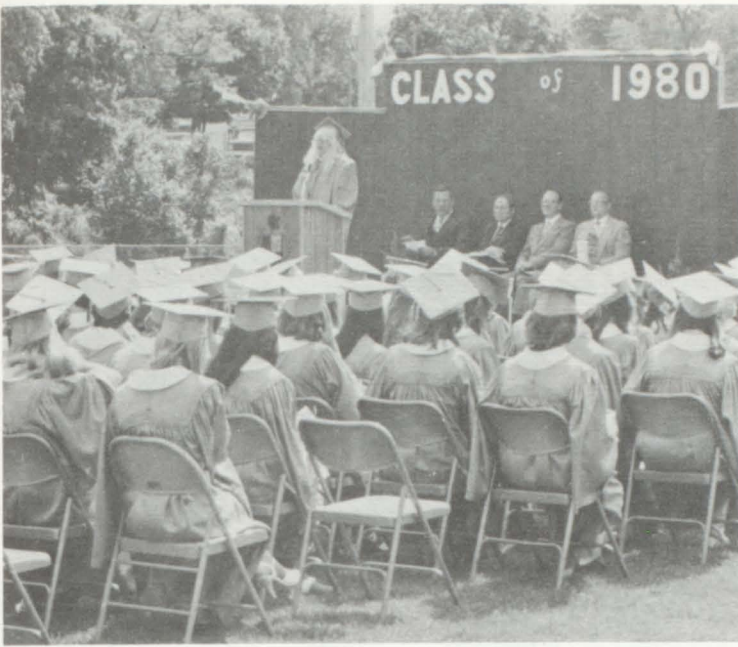


## COMMENCEMENT

## In Memory

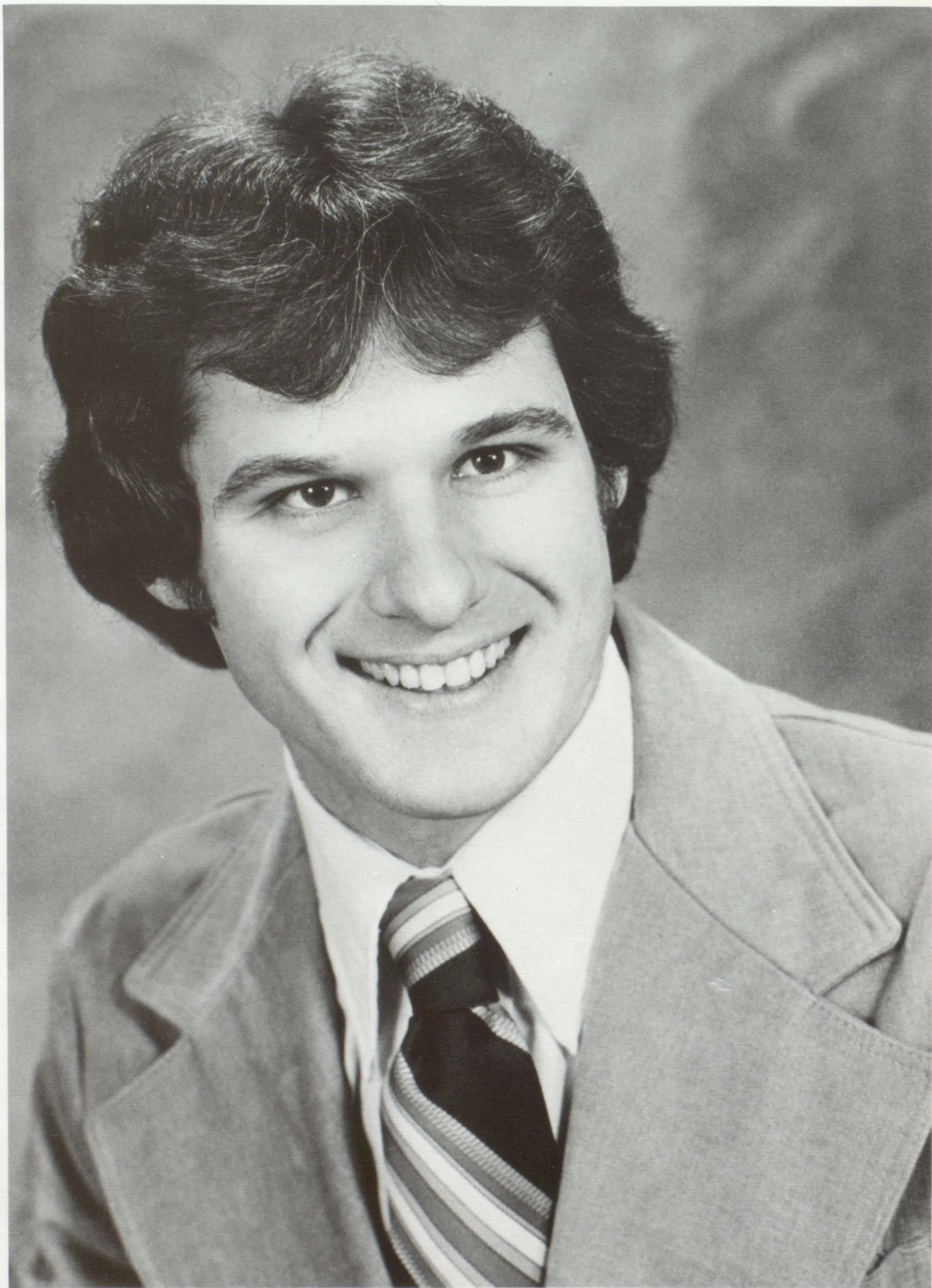


Neville L. Hart

Mr. Neville L. Hart, longtime resident of Tecumseh, died early in November of 1979, at the age of 68.

He first came into the Tecumseh school system in 1940 as a business teacher and coach. Mr. Hart coached both football and baseball, and in 1941, the Tecumseh Indians boasted an undefeated season, the first and last in the history of Tecumseh football. Mr. Hart was appointed principal in 1951 and will be remembered by all who felt the strength of his presence as a strict disciplinarian. Yet Mr. Hart was a fair man, and was well loved because of it. At the end of the 1972-73 school year, Mr. Hart went into retirement, but not until three hundred well-wishers honored him in the high school gymnasium. His recent passing brought tears and memories of a good man.

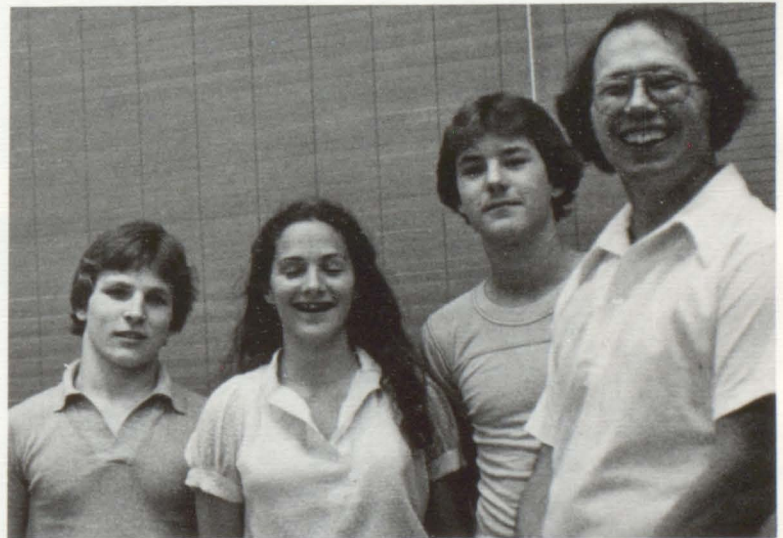


# SPANISH CLUB

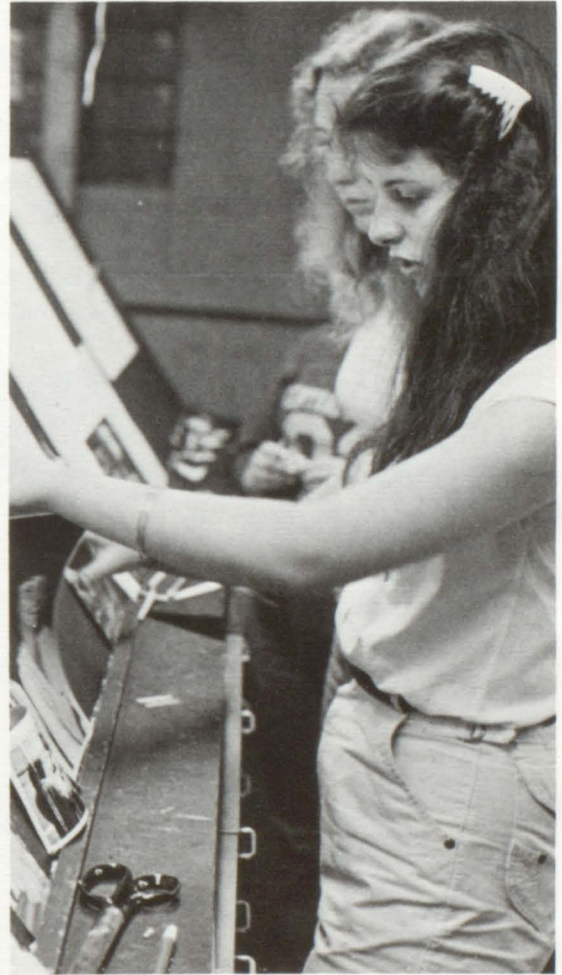
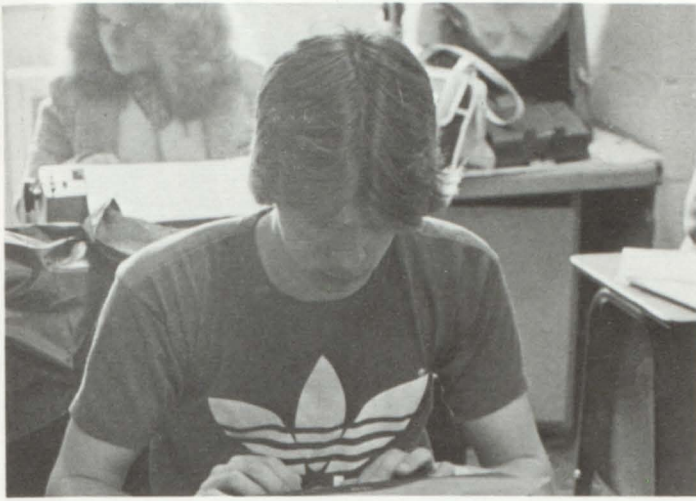


# ORANGE SPIRAL

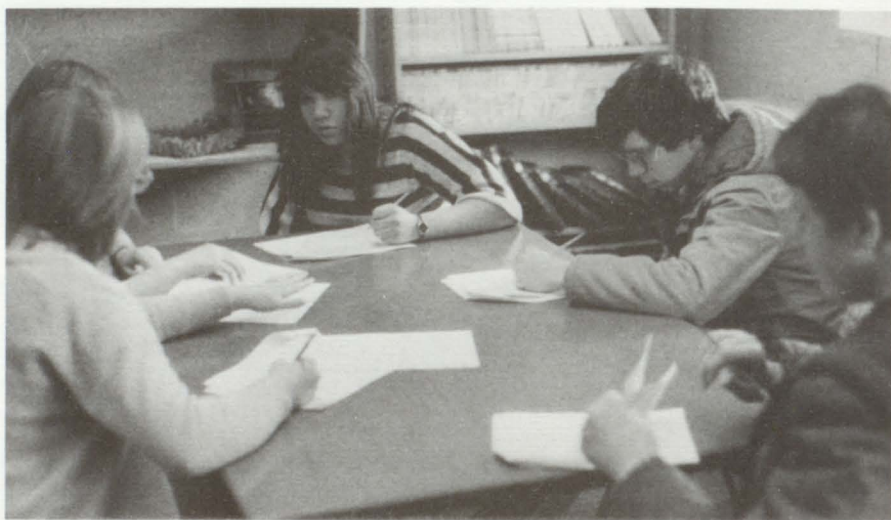
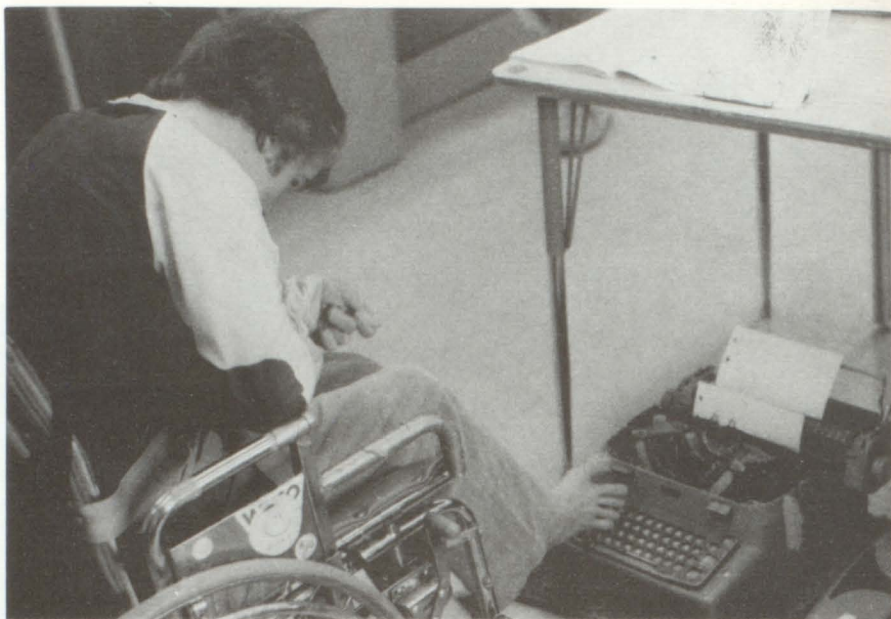

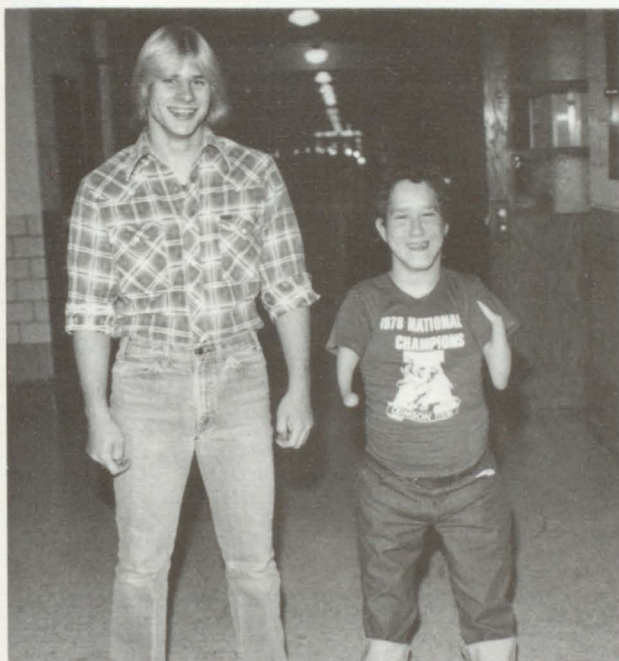
Mrs. Pobuda is in charge of the physically impaired students here at T.H.S. They are on the same type of educational programs as other students, and have an equal ability range.

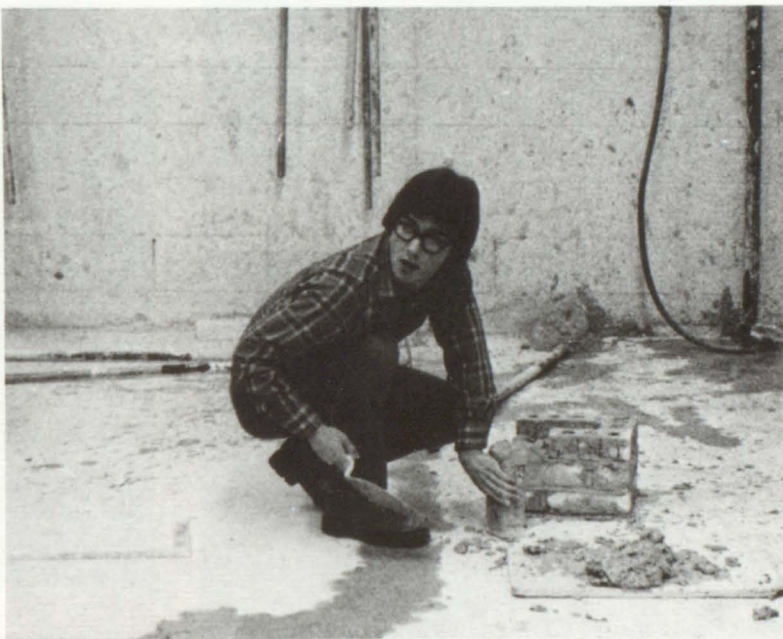


# VO-TECH

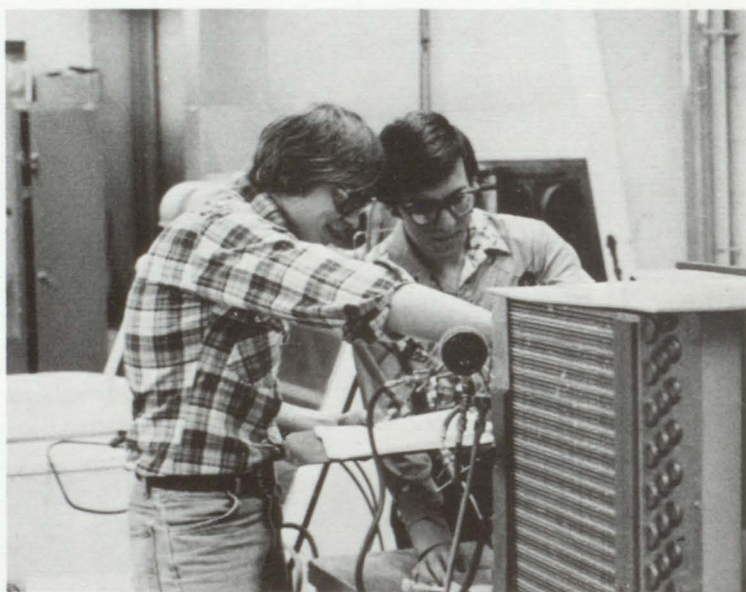

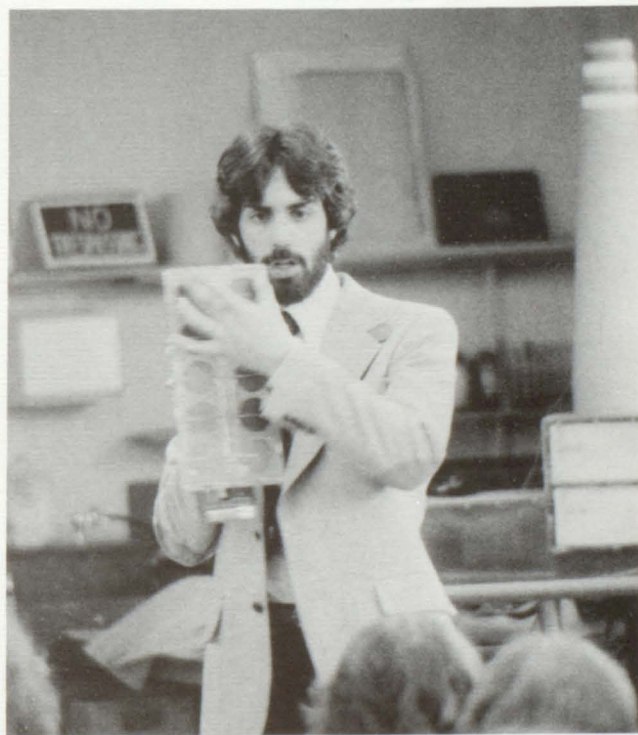




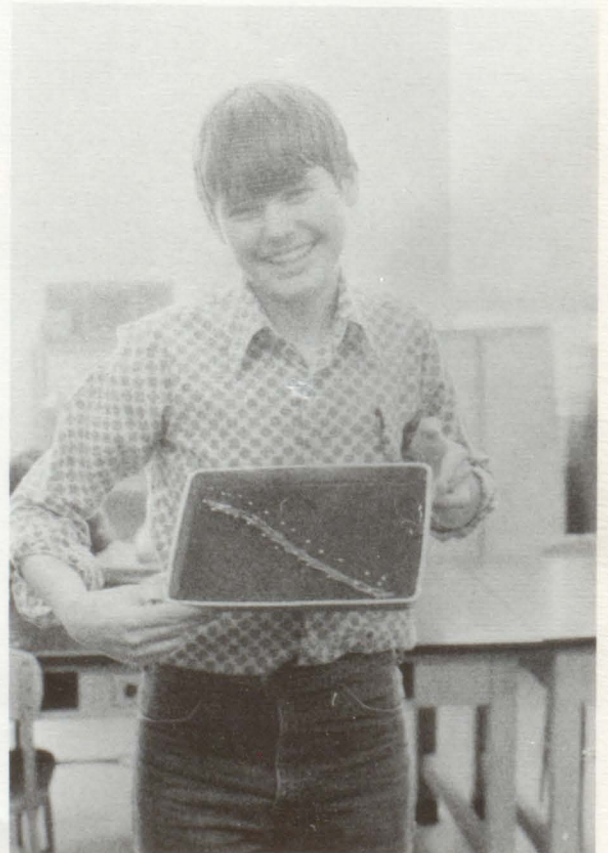












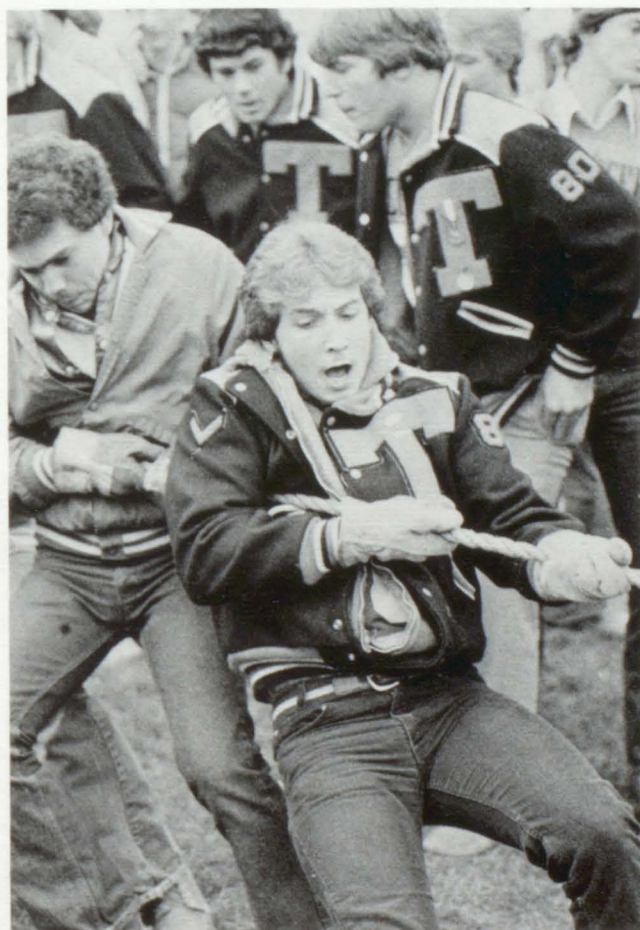








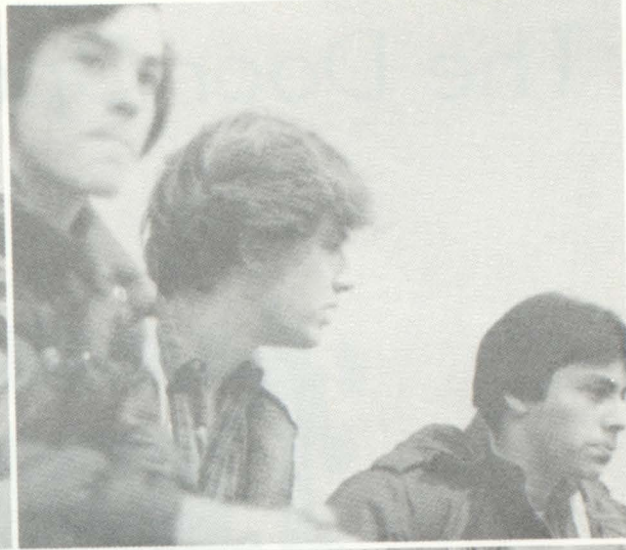












## EDITOR'S NOTE

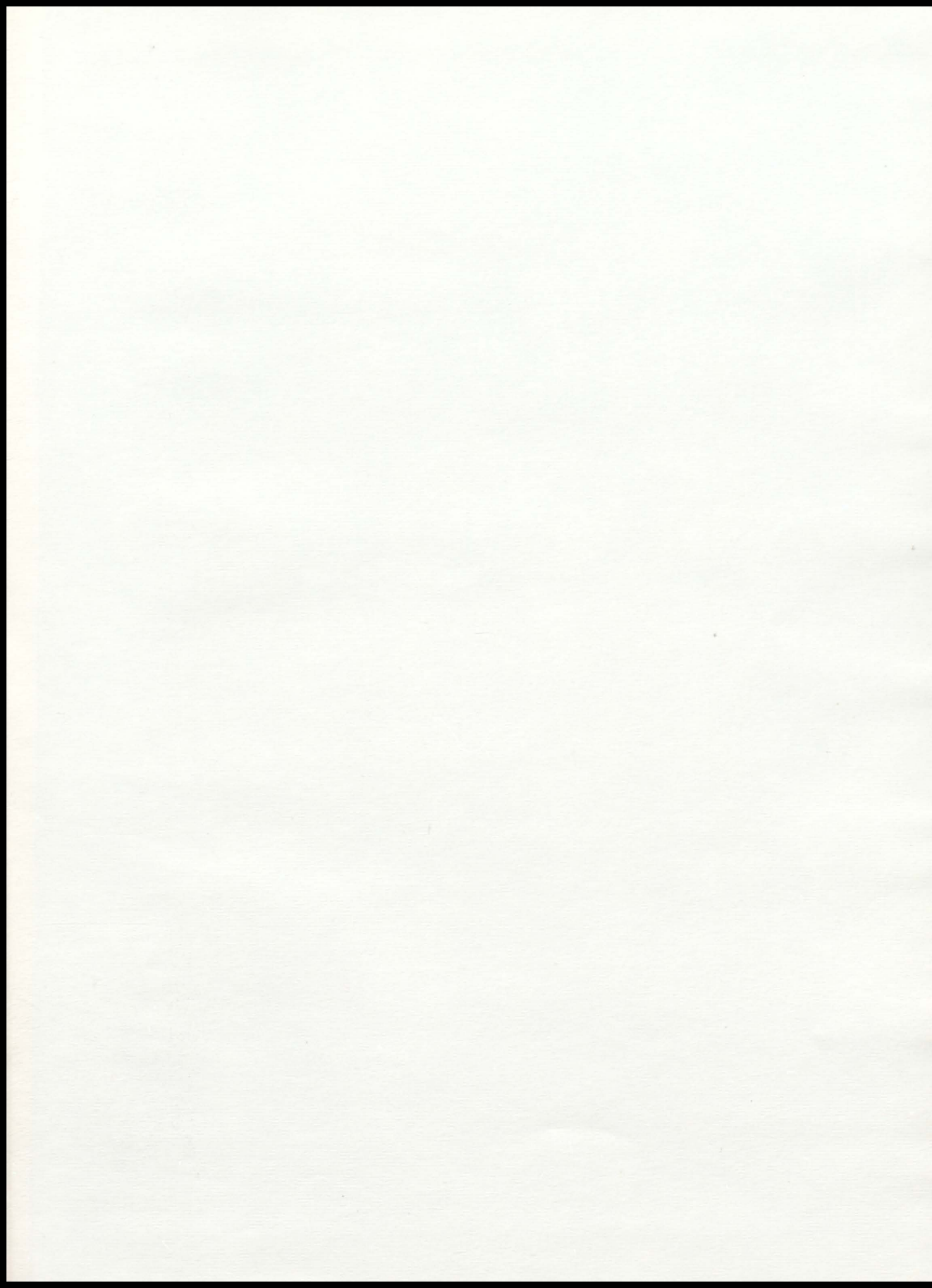

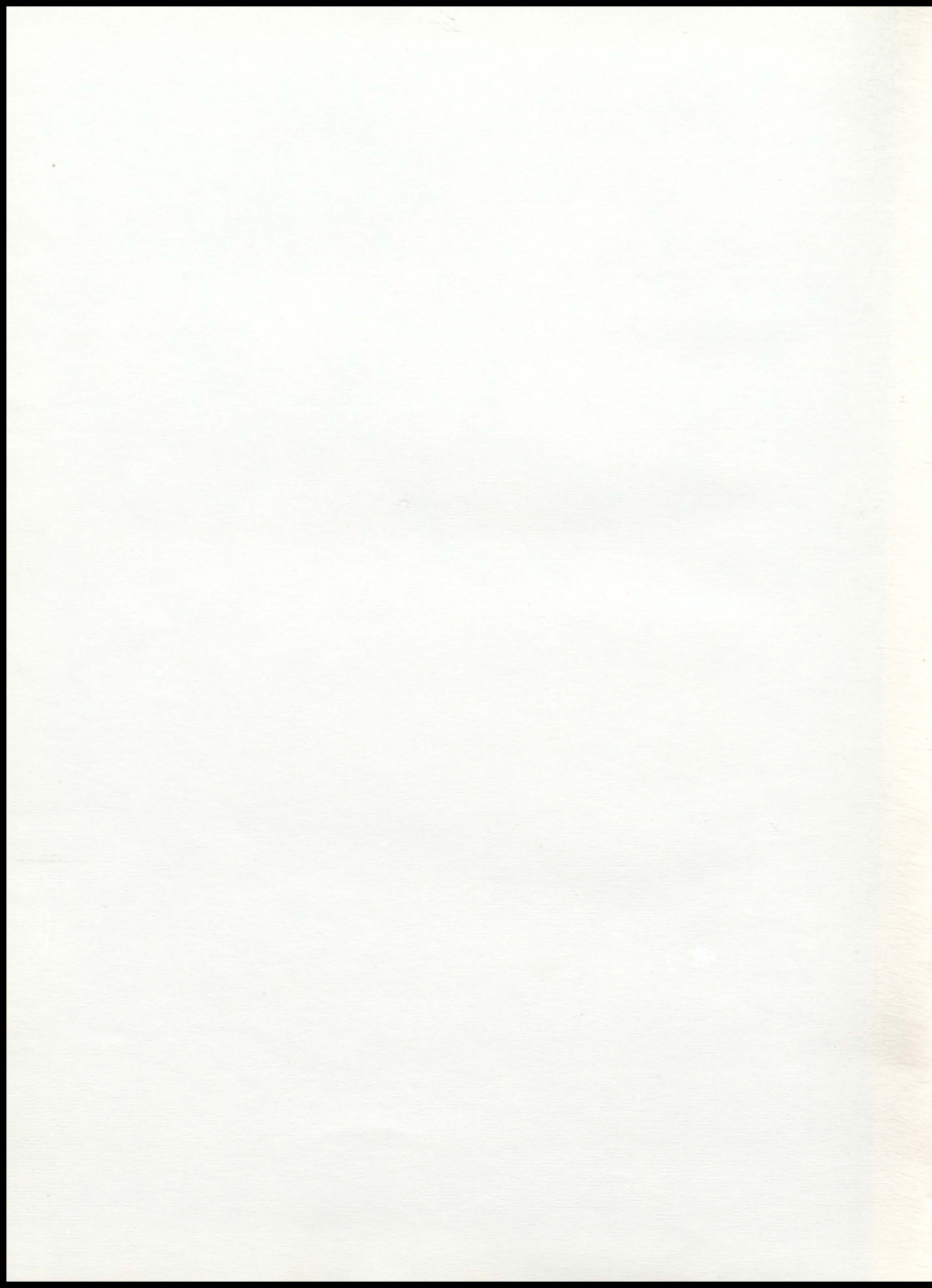

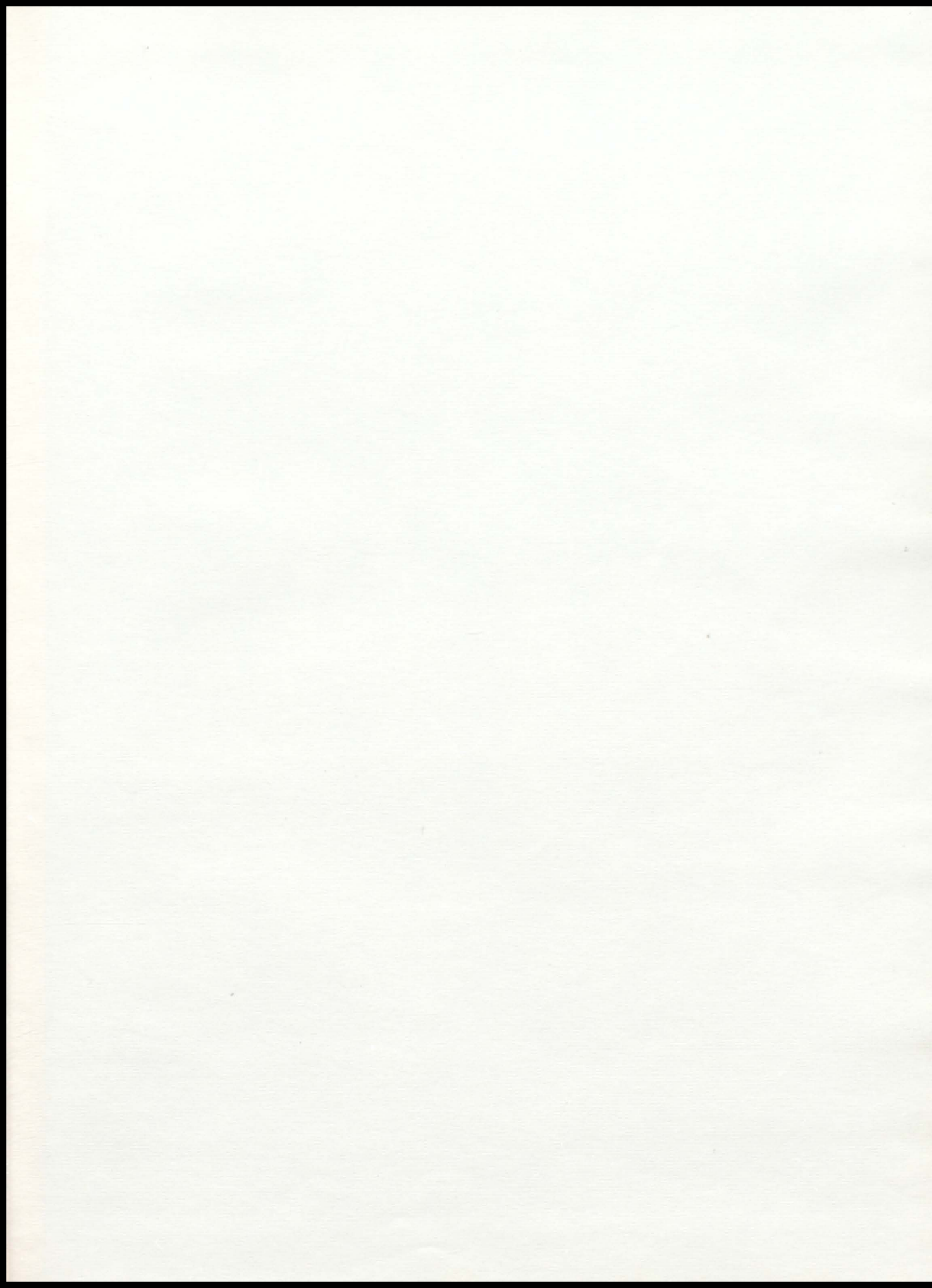
